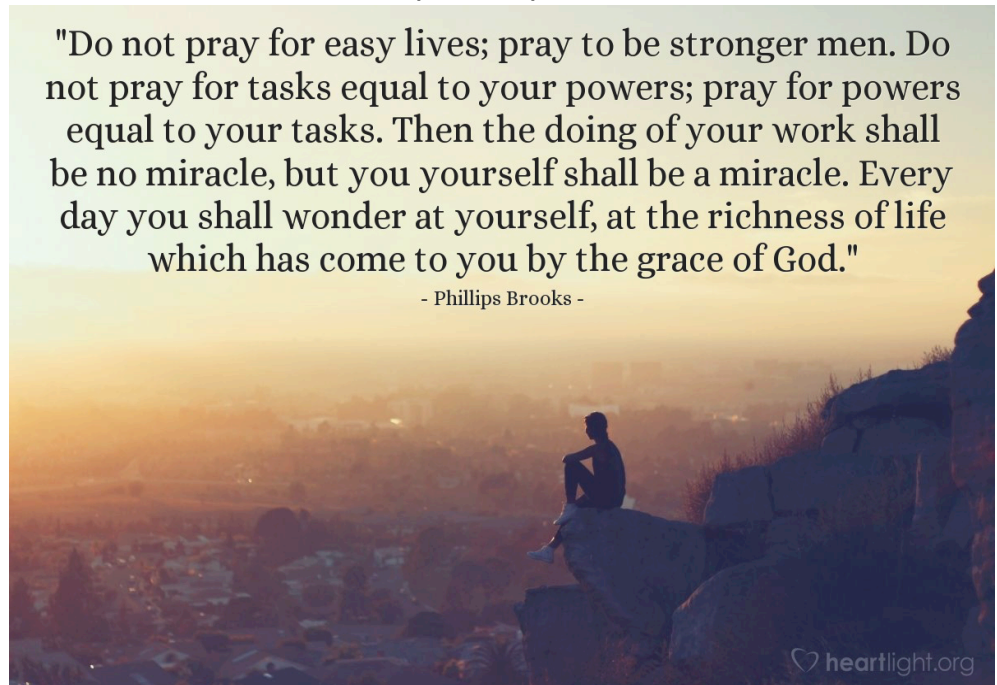

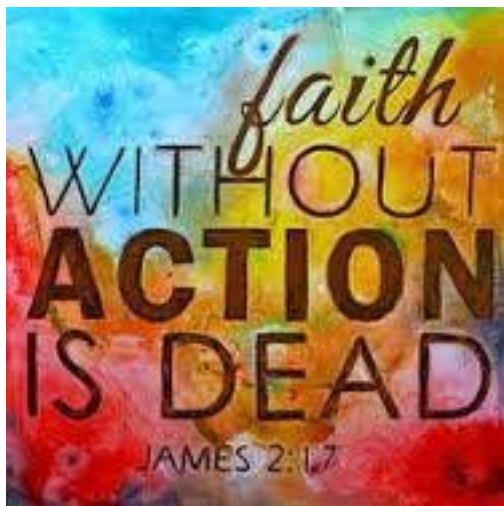


## Social Ministry

In the first 3 months of this year we are serving on an average of 40 families a week in the food pantry. It is gratifying to always have enough food to meet the needs of our community.

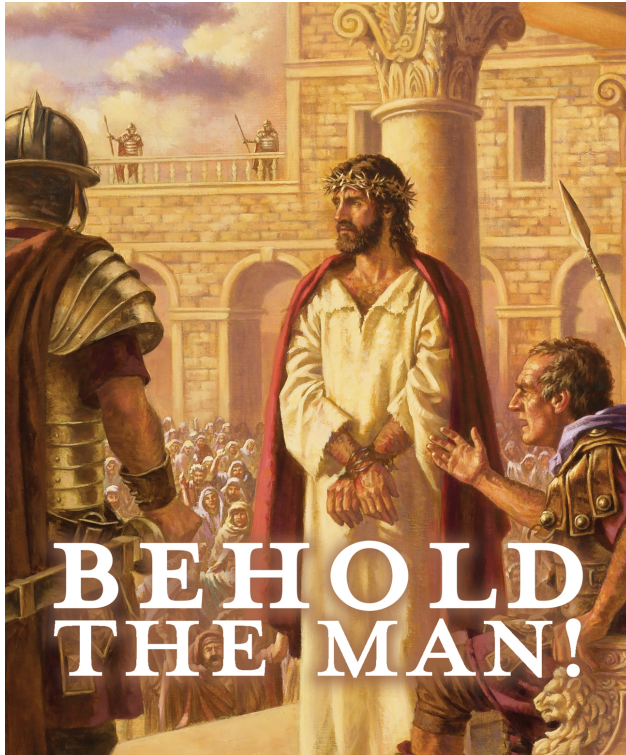
